

**The President's Club Parking Privileges
Rules and Regulations
Frequently Asked Questions**

How do I start the process to receive a parking permit?

How often can I use my parking permit?

Because this is a special parking privilege not accorded to the general public, faculty, staff or students, it may be used on an occasional basis only.

I am a faculty member/employee/student at the UA. May I use this permit instead of purchasing a University of Arizona parking permit?

No, you may not use these privileges for routine parking and must purchase a permit from Parking and Transportation to park in University facilities or pay the required fee in parking garages.

May I give my permit to someone else?

No – this privilege is only for members of The President's Club and is not transferable.

Parking at the University of Arizona is limited – where may I use my permit?

You may use your permit for:

- All regular spaces within Zone 1 and South of Sixth lots (hangtag must be visible);
- All parking garages, including Phoenix Biomedical Campus parking lot (swipe barcode at entry and exit gates – there is no need to display your hangtag when parked in a garage); and,
- Parking for special events (for example: football, basketball, UApresents), which will be accommodated in any of the pay parking lots at no cost on a space-available basis.

In what areas will my permit NOT be honored?

In order to meet the needs of the campus community, there are certain areas where members of The President's Club cannot park. These include:

- Campus parking meters unless the hourly fee is paid;
- Disabled parking spaces unless you have a state issued plate or placard;
- Lot Specific parking lots;
- Service and loading spaces during hours of control as posted on the signs;
- Specific reserved spaces located throughout campus;
- Lots reserved for special event parking permits (for example: lots reserved for football or basketball permit holders); and,
- Fire lanes, driveways and other parking areas.

All campus parking regulations are controlled year round except for official University holidays. If you have any questions, please contact UAF Donor Services at 520-621-5491. Will my original President's Club decal attached to the windshield allow me to park on campus?

It is no longer valid. Contact UAF Donor Services at 520-621-5491 or donorservices@al.arizona.edu to request a new parking permit.

How does the permit work in the garages?

Your permit also may be used as a swipe card to enter and exit UA parking garages. To use your permit as a swipe card, pull into the entry lane of the garage and stop your vehicle with your driver side window in line with the display/ticket dispenser. The swipe card reader is to the left of the ticket dispenser. Hold your permit so the barcode on the bottom aligns with the reader and run it through. The entrance gate will open automatically and you may proceed through the lane into the garage.

To exit the garage, drive directly to the exit gate and run your permit through the swipe card reader. You will no longer need to stop at the cashier and give your TPC number for an exit ticket.

Please note that two or more consecutive entrances or exits is improper use of the permit and may result in its deactivation.

What do I do if the machine in the garage will not read my permit? Where do I go?

If your permit does not work or you receive an error message, please use the cashier button located on the display/ticket dispenser to receive assistance. If the permit is defective, it will be replaced. Contact UAF Donor Services at 520-621-5491 or donorservices@al.arizona.edu to request a new parking permit. The original one must be returned.

For football and basketball games, are there maps so I may see where members of The President's Club may park for free?

May I get updated parking info online, such as maps, disabled parking or special events?

I lost/damaged my parking permit. How do I get a new one?

There is a \$25 fee to replace a lost or stolen parking permit. Contact UAF Donor Services at 520-621-5491 or donorservices@al.arizona.edu to request a replacement permit and payment instructions. When your new permit is issued, the former permit will be deactivated and will no longer be useable.

May I stop by the UA Foundation's office to pick up a permit?

All new permits must be mailed. You will not be able to pick up a new permit from our office. However, you may stop by our office to purchase a replacement for a damaged or lost permit, based on staff availability to assist you. When you receive a replacement, there is a 48 hour reactivation period for garage access, so you will not be able to use it immediately as a swipe card. You may use it without delay to park in any surface lot.
